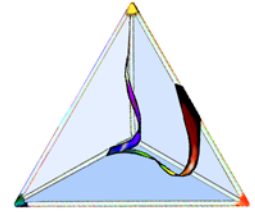

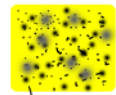
The **B** {Hebrew letter Bet: B-I-T בית House}  
 Be – Exist! - Distinguish: I/Thou, In/Out, Self/World  
 Bee – “Buzz” (“Bee” = “thing” = “word”, in Hebrew)  
 BeaT – Pulse - *Out and In*; Heart-Beat  
 BoTh – “Heaven and Earth”; mind and world)  
 BeTWEEN - “2” , Two/Twin; Be-Twine = Weave  
 6-NET BooTh / BoaT – Our Home  
 Hexagon BIT / BYTe - *Unit of Information = a Distinction*  
 Comb BeauT - *Flower*

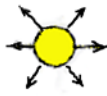

The **R** {Hebrew letter Resh: R-I-S ריש Headwater}  
 RaISes / aRISes - *Comes Out / Up / Down*  
 RADIATES like a staR (“st-r”=great-ReaChing)  
 Radial = like the Radius of a circle  
 RaCes to – Starts, INITIATES (*In the beginning...*)  
 RuSes , ReaSons - *Thinks Up*



The **A** {Hebrew letter Alef: A-L-P אלה All}  
 ALL / ALways – *Everything included, Everywhere*  
 Archetype, General/Master, *in General*  
 APPLe   
 ALooF  
 ALP




The **S** {Hebrew letter Shin: S-I-N שן Tooth}  
 Shows – Makes known  
 ShiNes – Like a Sun  
 ExpreSSes – -tion (suffix)

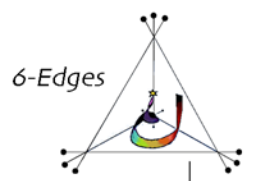


The **I** {Hebrew letter Yod: I-F-D יד Hand}  
 If – “I Flow” – A choice; Hand; Point/Pointer  
 I’m – Me  
 I – Individual; Iota

 Turns – Reflects all views like a mirror; like the buzz

**In the Beginning God Created . . .  
The Genesis of Mind and World**

**PREAMBLE**

If letters are gestures, then words are gestured sentences. So we read Genesis letter-by-letter. Each letter has a name, usually a noun. We're going to read the active verb-form of the noun, based on the idea that "God is a verb", and based on the fact that Biblical Hebrew uses verb-roots rather than noun-roots as modern languages do. Here's the result.

The pulse of the beat [of breath and heart]  
that initiates  
everything  
expresses  
every person and every personal choice  
and all of the feelings and doings [of mind and world].

[This] impulse  
breathes out and  
breathes in.  
[It] connects  
each individual [and each choice]  
to the entire cosmos.

The first letter is Bet (English B).

**Bet** means "house". It distinguishes inside from outside. All living "houses" breathe and pulse, establishing the boundary between inside and outside.

**Resh** means "head". Thus, Resh does what a head does: reaches, races, ruses, and rushes. Resh is the initial projector/projection/projecting.

**Alef** means "all". This is everything.

A **Shin** is a tooth, or anything else that expresses itself (teeth project from the jaw, and they express speech).

**Yod** is a hand, and the individual holding the hand and using their hand to make choices.

**Tav** is a line of reflection -- an infinity mirror that takes each and every individual and each and every choice, and by reflection enables it to reach the limits of mind and world.
